

Some Wonderful Niagara Falls Words of Wisdom

The natural wonder of the

Canadian Horseshoe Falls is one of the most famous waterfalls. With heights of 176 feet, and a colossal 150,000 gallons of water crashing down per second (picture about one million bathtubs filled with water every minute), it is no wonder Niagara Falls is so wondrous.

Niagara Falls is approximately 12,000 years old (and so the history books tell us).

The Falls were created when melting glaciers formed massive fresh-water lakes, called the Great Lakes. One of the lakes, Lake Erie ran downhill

toward another, Lake Ontario. The rushing waters carved out a river in their descent and at one point passed over a steep cliff like formation, the Niagara escarpment. From the original Falls going over the Niagara Escarpment, the water began to wear its way back up the river. The path that it left is known today as the Niagara Gorge, a deeply-cut and very scenic river path.

There are three different Falls that make up Niagara Falls: The American Falls, The Bridal Veil Falls and The Canadian Horseshoe Falls.



ELECTRICITY

Niagara Falls serves as a major source of electricity for Ontario. Hydro Electricity generated in Niagara Falls at the Sir Adam Beck 1 and Sir Adam Beck 2 power stations from redirected waterflow serves the electrical needs of Southern Ontario and Western New York.

FAMOUS

Niagara Falls is famous on the Big Screen. Well known for its leading roles in "Niagara," featuring Marilyn Monroe in 1953 and "Superman II," featuring Christopher Reeve and Margot Kidder. Niagara Falls receives a best supporting role in "Pirates of the Caribbean: At World's End" in the scene that shows the ship going over a waterfall. James Cameron, Canadian Film Director and Producer, and winner of three Academy Awards for Titanic, grew up in Chippawa, Ontario





Famous Address for Thrill Seekers, Attention-Seekers or as we like to call them Daredevils. Annie Taylor, "Queen of the Mist" was the 63 year old school teacher, who was looking for fame and fortune when she went over the Falls in a barrel along with her cat on October 24th, 1901. Jean Francois Gravelet, or "The Great Blondin" was the first of many tightrope walkers to cross the gorge of the Niagara River on a tightrope and live to tell his story.

Honeymoon Capital of the World

The Bridal Veil Falls is named in honour of our visits from honeymooners. Since 1949, just under 1 Million "Honeymoon Certificates" were signed by the Mayor, which proves that guests spent their official "honeymoon" here.

According to Trip Advisor, Niagara Falls is one of the Top Destinations in Canada.



War of 1812 Bicentennial

Bicentennial Celebrations of the War of 1812 began across Niagara in June 2012 and will continue until February 2015. The three year celebration marks 200 years of peace between Canada and the U.S. The War of 1812 played a pivotal role in the shaping of our nation, and the impact on the residents of Niagara was tremendous. For three years, the residents of Niagara Falls lived on the front lines of this global conflict, with two major battles (Chippawa and Lundy's Lane) taking place within the boundaries of the present City of Niagara Falls.

Cultural Capital of Canada

Niagara's ongoing commitment to its strong cultural integration within the Region has helped earn its designation as the Cultural Capital of Canada for 2012. Local events included the opening of the Niagara Falls History Museum; A Walk Through History Cemeteries Tours; The Carmel Fine Art and Music Festival; and Niagara Falls Night of Art: Creative Currents. www.niagaraculture2012.ca

Sought out by the Stars

Niagara Falls has been on the radar of many celebrities and politicians around the world for centuries: King Henry VI, Charles Dickens, Mark Twain, Shirley Temple, Princess Margaret, Princess Diana with Prince William and Prince Harry, Christopher Reeve...the list is endless.

2012 was a Big Year for Famous Niagara Events

First there was the Wallenda Walk on June 15th, where Nik Wallenda courageously walked across

Niagara Falls on a 550 metre wire in 25 minutes. The TV viewership was estimated in the millons.

Next was the Red Bull Crashed Ice Global Tour, which kicked off for the first time in Niagara Falls on December 1st. This event called for extreme winter sports enthusiasts to race down a 460 metre icy track, four at a time, reaching speeds of 60 km/hr on ice skates. Yes you heard us correctly. Ice Skates.

Flow of Water Stops for a Day

The flow of water was stopped completely over both Falls on March 29th, 1848 due to an ice jam in the upper river for several hours. This is the only known time this has occurred. The Falls did not actually freeze over, but the flow was stopped to the point where people actually walked out and recovered artifacts from the riverbed.

The Niagara Escarpment

(a UNESCO World Biosphere Reserve) is the top of the list for hikers. It's a world unto itself, encompassing farms, recreation areas, sweeping

scenic views, 1675 foot cliffs, streams, wetlands, rolling hills, waterfalls, wildlife and so much history. The Niagara Escarpment's hiking trail is most commonly known as the Bruce Trail, which starts at Queenston Heights and takes a diagonal path 773 km through Southern Ontario to the tip, Tobermory on the Bruce Trail.

The Niagara River Recreation Trail

This 56 km scenic paved trail runs parallel to the Niagara River from historic Fort Erie in the South to Fort George in the North. At the halfway point, you can't miss the natural wonder, Niagara Falls.

is truly a tropical adventure. They are the world's largest freeflying indoor aviary, featuring 400 birds flying free in 50,000 square feet of tropical rainforest, a 40 foot

waterfall, tropical plants, exotic reptiles and so much more.

The Butterfly Conservatory is located on the grounds of the Botanical Gardens. This magical attraction features more than 2000 colourful, tropical butterflies floating freely in a rainforest setting. During your visit, you may even get to experience the very first flight of a butterfly through the Emergence window.

The Maid of the Mist is an attraction that is a combination of Man-Made and Mother Nature inspired. It is the second most popular attraction, right behind the majestic natural wonder. This half hour journey will be the thrill of a lifetime. The Maid departs from the Canadian docks, passing the base of the American Falls, taking you into the basin of the magnificent Canadian Horseshoe Falls. FUN FACT #3

Clifton Hill owes its name to Captain Ogden Creighton, a half-pay officer in the British army who had served with the 70th and 81st Regiments in various parts of the world. He had plans for a town site with custom homes which he named Clifton, presumably after Clifton on the gorge of the River Avon in Bristol, England.
